President's Cup is awarded to the single-highest percentage ride by a KDA member in good standing\* at the KDA Annual May show (excluding materiale, equitation, and young horse *FEI classes for 4-6vos).* 

### THE 2019 RAPUNZEL MEMORIAL PERPETUAL AWARD

Angela Jackson - Royal Heiress - 77.5

The Rapunzel Memorial Perpetual Award is presented at the annual KDA banquet to the highest-scoring mare from a KDA/USDF recognized show. The mare's highest individual score will be from a training level through Grand Prix test (materiale, young horse, and Freestyle classes excluded). The rider must be a KDA member in good standing and all KDA recognized shows counting for the current year-end awards will be considered for the highest score. The trophy base will be engraved with the rider's name, horse's name, level shown, and score. The winner will keep the perpetual trophy for one year and return at the following year's banquet.


### THE NANCY BASSETT MEMORIAL TROPHY FOR THE MATERIALE HORSE OF THE YEAR

This year's recipient is Rebekah Mengari riding Killian TF - 79.25

This perpetual trophy is awarded to the high-scoring Materiale horse regardless of sex/age group over the calendar year.

Nancy Bassett was a superb horsewoman, who dedicated her life to nursing and helping others. She was born and raised in Ann Arbor, MI and enjoyed encouraging everyone around her to do their best and believe in themselves. Nancy was a true supporter of following your dreams and believed that all problems with horses can be solved with patience and self-reflection. Her bubbly personality and big smile brightened up every home, barn or hospital room she walked into. Nancy was diagnosed with a brain tumor in 2006, which was discovered after she had a fall from a horse. She passed away in April 2008, but will always be remembered by those she encouraged and inspired.

### This clinic is free to everyone!

Applications are now open for the 2020 Retired Racehorse Project Thoroughbred Makeover presented by Thoroughbred Charities of America! Applications are accepted through January 15, 2020, with accepted trainers announced on February 15, 2020.

The Thoroughbred Makeover features competition in ten disciplines for recently-retired Thoroughbreds in their first year of retraining for a second career after racing. Disciplines include barrel racing, competitive trail, dressage, eventing, field hunters, freestyle, polo, show hunter, show jumper, and ranch work. Horses and trainers will compete for more than \$125,000 in total prize money at the Kentucky Horse Park on October 7-10, 2020.

Dressage and Eventing are both perennial favorite disciplines at the Thoroughbred Makeover with over 100 entries in both 2018 and 2019, and graduates are enjoying success in recognized competition across the US. Debuting at the 2019 Thoroughbred Makeover, Western Dressage is now an entry option for trainers as well.

The Makeover is open to professionals, amateurs, juniors (ages 12 and older) and teams. Team entry allows riding schools or lesson programs to share in the process of preparing and retraining an off-track Thoroughbred for a second career. Approved trainers may acquire eligible Thoroughbred through whatever source they choose; for full eligibility and competition rules please review the 2020 rulebook.


